Topic Study - Simple Machines.

The over-arching theme for this term is Simple Machines. We will be learning about Early Civilisations, use of technology, how simple machines are applied and have been innovated upon and famous inventions.

In mathematics we will be revisiting our basic algorithmic processes, looking at fractions and decimals, using standard units of measurement, and working with statistics.
