COVID - 19 LEVEL 2

The Prime Minister has directed a level 3 lockdown from Wellsford to Pukekohe. She has requested the remainder of the country to enact level 2 procedures, for the next 3 days.

This is so contact tracing of the confirmed cases can occur.

Over the past 5 days many members of our school community have travelled to, or have had personal contact with Auckland residents.

Therefore our school response at this stage is as follows.

If you wish to keep your child home for the next three days do so, however school will be open as usual enacting the following procedures.

- Utilise the pre-defined entry and exit point.
- Sanitise prior to touching the door handle
- Stay away from school if exhibiting any flu like or Covid symptoms
- Drinking fountains closed
- Social distancing where-ever possible
- All visitors report to the office and sign in the Covid register.
- Class as normal.

We will update you of any status change, via text, our website, and by newsletter.

If we go hard and fast now with our response we will beat back Covid - 19 again. Complacency is not an option.
