## Resource 23: Scenario statements

A boyfriend and girlfriend hold hands at the movies.

A mother cuddles and kisses her baby.

A young man says yes when a young woman asks if she can kiss him.

At a whānau get-together, the relatives greet each other with a hug and kiss.

A man gives his husband flowers as a surprise.

A girl wants to sit next to a boy in her class every chance she gets.

A boy sends a Valentine's card to a girl he likes but is too shy to talk to.

Two girls take a photo of a girl talking to a boy, then post it online with a heart around it and a caption about them being in love. The students are not boyfriend and girlfriend.

A boy asks his girlfriend to stay over while his parents are away. She doesn't feel comfortable with it and says no.

A couple agree that once a month, they will go on a date where one picks an activity or outing that they think will appeal to their partner.

A girl feels attracted to one of her friends. She writes the friend a letter explaining her feelings.

A boy and girl go on their first date. Later the boy changes his Facebook status to 'in a relationship' and describes the date in a post. He adds details that aren't true.
