It is with regret that I have to announce we will not be going to Tui Ridge - Rotorua for our school camp.

Despite being promoted since December 2018, thus far we have only received payment (either full or partial) from 65/171 families, therefore we have to reset our goal.

This is disappointing, however when life gives you lemons, make lemonade.

We are currently working on Northland based alternatives for our Outdoor Education Experience. We do have money put aside in the budget, plus monies raised via plant sales and PTA fundraisers. These coupled with a smaller contribution from families should enable us to have similar learning experiences locally.
